It offers a comprehensive treatment of fundamental principles, instrumentation, analytical methods, and applications. It also provides an overview of the label-free contrast available from lifetime measurements of tissue autofluorescence and the prospects for exploiting this for clinical applications and biomedical research including drug discovery.

Fluorescence Lifetime Spectroscopy and Imaging

The results of short-time elevated-temperature creep tests of 75S-T6 aluminum-alloy columns are presented and examined with the objective of obtaining procedures for predicting column lifetime. Semiempirical lifetime curves are obtained withthe air of a previously published column creep theory and are used for deriving column curves. The semiempirical lifetime curves are also used to study the effect of varying applied stress and out-of-straightness. In the range considered, small variations of out-of-straightness are found to be of little practical significance; whereas, small stress variations change column lifetime considerably. For the range of out-of-straightness, and plots of this type should be satisfactory for predicting column lifetime for design purposes.

Representatives from 23 modeling groups using 29 models participated in these MM II excercises between 1996 and 1999. Twelve of the models were two-dimensional zonal-mean models while 17 were three-dimensional models. This was an international effort as seven were from outside the U.S.A. Six transport experiments and five chemistry experiments were designed for various models. Models participating in the transport experiments performed simulations of chemically inert tracers providing diagnostics for transport. The chemistry experiments involved simulating the distributions of chemically active trace gases including ozone.
