Number 1: Unused RAM is Wasted RAM
Number 2: High CPU usage is often a good thing
Number 3: inodes (and how that impacts available storage space)
Number 4: The large number of Linux distributions is a GOOD thing
Number 5: Set up LVM on every server

- Number 6: Nobody memorizes all the commands and options
- Number 7: Always have a backup distribution
- Number 8: Version control (Git, etc) isn't only useful for software engineers
- Number 9: LVM snapshots exist
- Number 10: Ensure backup jobs reference ALL disks, even those that were newly added
